Facility Use Policy

SwimMAC is fortunate to be associated with Queens University and have the use of its facility for Team Elite athletes and scheduled clinic and camp events. Coaches, swimmers, and parents are to follow the procedures listed below. **Please remember the use of Queens University is by invitation only and specific instructions will be given to you by the coach for the event.**

Drop off/ Pick up

You may drop your swimmers off along Wellesley next to the Levine entrance (look for Pool entrance signage) 15 minutes before an event starts, but no earlier. Instruct your swimmers to stay on the sidewalks and off the grass or planted areas. On occasion, Queens University will have activities that require the use of the parking lot. You will be notified of these days and given directions for drop-off and pick-up. Parking may be limited during such events. Please note that Queens University is located in a neighborhood and be respectful of homeowners and residents. Parking is available in the lot behind the building adjacent to the soccer fields. Be aware that University parking decals are required during class hours. SwimMAC Carolina and Queens University staff are not responsible for parking citations.

Pool Access

Enter the Levine center through the main entrance (unless specifically instructed to use side entrance during non-open hours) and let the front desk staff know the event you are attending. Parents are welcome to watch the event from the bleacher area.

All SwimMAC members must stay in the pool area. Use the swimmers' bathrooms in the locker rooms located on the pool deck. Other areas of the Levine Center are off-limits. Children should be closely supervised as a courtesy to others and for their safety.

Locker Rooms

Swimmers must stay in the pool area or the locker room at all times. Leave the pool area and the locker rooms as you found them. Turn off the showers, pick up trash, and don't leave locks on the lockers. Be respectful of other groups and remember that you are a guest in the facility. Use the same common courtesy you would use if you were a guest in someone else's home.

Please note that use of the Queens Swimming facilities is by invitation only and under the supervision of a MAC staff member at all times.
